Scholastic Area:

Remodeled assessment structure effective from the Academic year 2023 – 2024 for Class X and same will be followed for Class IX: - CBSE/ACADEMIC/JS(SS)/2023/ as per ACAD 45/2023

- For Class X Compulsory Board Examination for 80 marks [Competency based question would be minimum 50%, These can be in the form of Multiple-Choice Questions, case-based questions, source based integrated or any other type. Objective type questions will be 20%. Remaining 30% short and long answer question.].
- 20 marks for Internal Assessment.
 [Final Grades will be: Marks 91-100 = A1, 81-90 = A2, 71-80 = B1, 61-70 = B2, 51-60 = C1, 41-50 = C2, 33-40 = D, 32 & below = E (Failed)]
- 3. Internal Assessment: -
- (i) Two periodic written examinations in the entire academic year, (Term I & II) written examination [Weightage 10 marks (5 pen paper test + 5 Multiple Assessment*) out of 20 marks].
- *Multiple Assessments: strategies to be used. (Quizzes, oral test, concept map, exit cards, visual expression etc.)
- (iii) Note Book submission (Weightage 5 marks out of 20 marks) Regularity, Punctuality, Assignment completion, Neatness & upkeep of notebook, peer assessment, self-assessment, achievements of student in subject, reflections narrations, journals, etc.
- (iv) <u>Subject Enrichment Activity</u> (Weightage 5 marks out of 20 marks) Speaking & Listening skills for Languages, Practical Lab. work for Science, Math Lab. work for Mathematics and Map work and Project work in Social Science.
- 4. For Class VI to VIII Same procedure as in Class IX & X in Term I and Term II. Final written Examination for 80 marks (20+60).
 [Final Grades for Term I and Term II will be: Marks 91-100 = A1, 81-90 = A2, 71-80 = B1, 61-70 = B2, 51-60 = C1, 41-50 = C2, 33-40 = D, 32 & below = E (Needs improvement)]
- 5. Marking & Grading procedure will be followed for Class I to V same as in Class VI to VIII.
- For Class XI and XII Two Unit tests 40 marks each. Half yearly Examination and Final Examination/Board examination 100 marks each, and Internal Assessment 10 marks (homework, note book submission, assignment completion 10 marks in each term.)
- 7. Class 11 & 12 pattern of Half yearly & final examination 100 Marks; Compulsory portion of Internal Assessment/Project work/Practical in all subjects of 20/30 marks. Written examination 80/70 marks: [Competency based questions would be minimum 40% These can be in the form of Multiple-choice questions, case based Integrated questions or any other types. Objective type MCQ questions will be 20%. Remaining 40% Constructed response type short and long answer questions.]
- Class LKG, UKG Half Yearly and Final Examination.

Co-Scholastic Area:

Following Activities will be graded on a 5-point grading scale (A to E) for Class IX and X, and 3-point grading for Class I to VIII (A to C) and will have no descriptive indicators, no up scaling of grades will be done. Class XI & XII Work Experience, Physical & Health Education, General Studies will be graded on nine-point grading: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2, D1, D2, and E.

[First arrange Marks with names in Rank -1st 1/8 students =A1, 2^{nd} 1/8 = A2, 3^{rd} 1/8=B1, 4^{th} 1/8=B2, 5^{th} 1/8 = C1, 6^{th} 1/8 = C2, 7^{th} 1/8 = D1, 8^{th} 1/8 = D2].
